Dear Parent/carers,

When we wrote to you earlier in the week about the possible wider re-opening of schools, we explained that we would only do this following Government confirmation that:

- The five key tests are met
- The rate of infection continues to decrease.
- Local Public Health advice.

Today we have received further clarification from the Director of Public Health for Doncaster, confirming his advice that schools should NOT reopen to wider groups. As such, Highfields Primary Academy, will not re-open to wider year groups in the week beginning the 1st June.

We will continue to review the possible wider re-opening of schools on a regular basis, following the advice of the Director of Public Health and will update you accordingly.

The academy will be open to provide childcare for vulnerable pupils and the children of key workers. Thank you for your continued support and understanding.
